Monthly Activity Report - December, 2013

Building Administrative:

No new unsafe structures observed during the month of December. One unsafe structure pending for County removal.

The Building Department issued 471 permits in December, 3 less than issued in November. Permit revenues received for December were \$103,035 or 15% higher than November permit revenues of \$89,662. For comparison, there were 371 permits issued in December, 2012.

The Building Department continues preparation on a new Floodplain Ordinance. Our current Floodplain Ordinance requires revisions to meet 2010 Florida Building Code that satisfies the minimum requirements of the National Flood Insurance Program. The Building Department continued to scan documents for digital archival of records during December as time permitted. Digital archived records ensure that public records are created, maintained and disposed of in accordance with Florida Statutes. The digital archival of records also enables public records requests for permit and plans information to be completed in a more timely and efficient manner.

Permitting Department:

The Permitting Department processed and issued the following permits for the month of December, 2013 (See attached for detail)

38 New Single-family residence permits

- a. 6 at less than \$200,000 valuation
- b. 10 at \$200,000 to \$250,000 valuation
- c. 22 above \$250,000 valuation
- 5 Mobile/Modular home permits

428 Accessory permits (Mechanical, Plumbing, additions, repairs, etc)

The department is continuing to average seven to ten days for the issuance of new single-family residence and mobile home permits with some repair/remodel and addition permits being issued in less than a week and two weeks on commercial projects provided there are no unforeseen problems with the application.

Inspections Department:

Building Inspectors completed 1695 inspections in December. One stop work order was posted due to construction being started without the proper building permit being issued.

A Building Inspector I passed examination and received certification as a Commercial Building Inspector.
