## A1A (State Road 200) traffic shift scheduled Sunday

**Yulee** – Eastbound traffic on A1A (State Road 200) is scheduled to shift from the current temporary lanes to the new eastbound lanes between Still Quarters Road and North Harts Road near the CSX railroad crossing on Sunday, according to the Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT).

The new lanes are part of the A1A six-lane widening project that began in September 2014. The 1½-mile long section from west of Still Quarters Road to west of Rubin Davis Lane includes designated bike lanes, sidewalks and new drainage system. In addition, the traffic signal at U.S. 17 will be updated to provide for the new lanes and turn lanes. The project is scheduled to be completed in early 2017.
