A1A (S.R.200) Widening Project Begins

Jacksonville – Florida Department of Transportation begins a widening project on A1A (State Road 200) to six lanes from west of Still Quarters Road to West of Rubin Davis Lane beginning the first week of September.

J.B. Coxwell Contracting, Inc. of Jacksonville is the contractor. The first segment of the project is scheduled for completion spring 2017 at a cost of \$18.5 million.

Beginning the first week of September motorists can expect to see construction alongside A1A as drainage, concrete work and construction of a temporary road is accomplished. Two lanes in each direction will be kept open between 6 a.m. and 9 p.m. Lane closures can be expected between 9 p.m. and 6 a.m.

State Road A1A is a significant east-west route and evacuation route between Interstate 95 and the Amelia Island and Fernandina Beach area. Three segments are scheduled that will widen A1A to six lanes between I-95 and County Road 107.

The second segment of the project is scheduled to begin spring 2016 from west of Rubin Davis Lane to east of County Road 107/Scott Road. Segment three is scheduled to begin early 2017 from Interstate 95 to west of Still Quarters Road.

Motorists should use caution when traveling through the construction site. Speeding fines are doubled as required by state law when workers are present.
