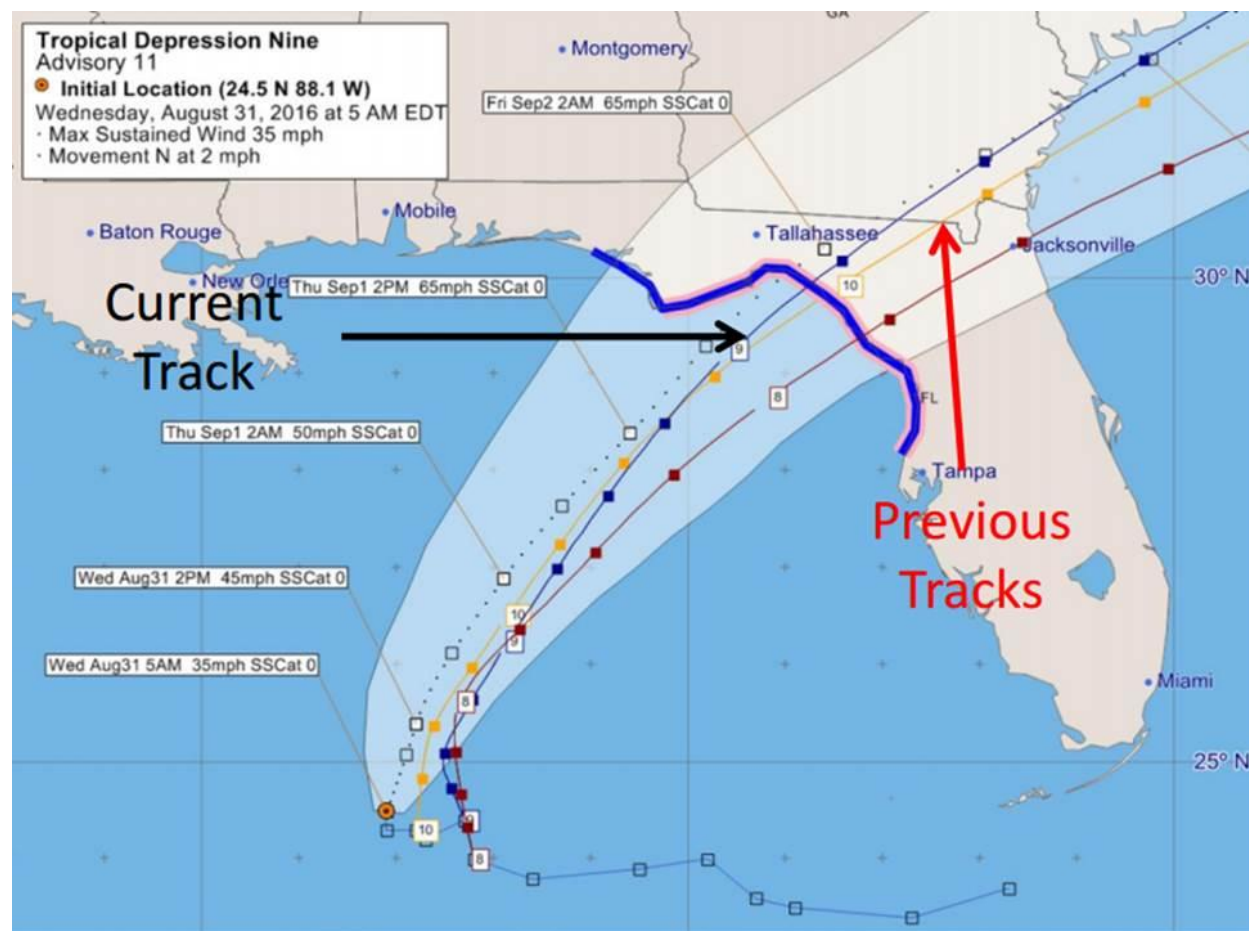
Event: **Tropical Depression 9**

EOC Activation: **Level 3 Monitoring**

Date & Time: **31 August 2016; 0900 hrs.**

Situation Summary

TD9 is slowly meandering in the Gulf and has not made its expected eastward turn. The Forecast Track has shifted slightly north and west of the previous three forecast tracks. This increases the wind threat over southeastern Georgia and reduces it over the Port of Jacksonville. While Nassau is still in the cone, the storm's westward shift should reduce potential impacts. Nassau County EOC will remain at Level 3 (monitoring) today and will relay any changes in the storm's strength or projected path.
